Course Information – Standard 11 Surface Mining Induction

Cost: \$870 for 3 days training and assessment including certificate and RRTO Induction Card.
Maximum of 14 participants per course.

Qualification: Nationally Recognised Certificate III in Surface Extraction Operations units

RIICOM201A: Communicate in the workplace

RIIGOV201A: Comply with site work processes/procedures

RIIOHS201A: Work safely and follow OHS policies and procedures

RIIERR205A: Apply initial response first aid

Course Description:

It is delivered in the classroom and includes participation in mining related scenarios to give students an understanding of what is expected to work safely on a mine site. On successful completion of this classroom based learning the student will be supplied with a Resources RTO Association induction card and a Workplace Assessment Book. When this book has been completed and returned to OHSA a Statement of Attainment can then be issued for the course Units of Competency.

Target Audience:

This program is designed to meet the new Standard 11 requirements for induction training. All people considering this course should take into consideration the individual mine site requirements.

Course Requirements:

Participants must provide photographic identification (i.e. driver's licence, passport). Closed shoes must also be worn.

Assessments & Awards:

Participants who demonstrate competency by passing both the theory and practical assessments will receive a Statement of Attainment in completion of the Resources RTO Induction - Surface Mining.

Students will receive a Statement of Completion Certificate for the theory components of the six (6) units (as required by the Mines Inspectorate Standard 11 General Induction) within 10 business days of the course



completion and a colour plastic RRTO Mining Induction card with the students photo identification at the end of the 3 day course with the theory components ticked. The student will also receive a Workplace Assessment Log Book to have completed on site. Upon return of the completed log book a Statement of Attainment will be produced and another RRTO Mining Induction Card will be produced with both theory and practical components ticked. Students will need to attend a one day refresher course every 5 years.

Entry Requirements:

Participants should have sufficient literacy and numeracy to read and comprehend instructions for safety at the workplace. Participants will need sufficient physical ability to attend a classroom based course, perform CPR floor demonstration exercises and lift and carry an approx. 10kg fire extinguisher to extinguish a fire.
